Section A. High School Completion Status

- A copy of the student's high school diploma.
- A copy of the student's final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.

A copy of the student's General Educational Development (GED) certificate or GED transcript.

- An academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.
- If State law requires a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.
- If State law does not require a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for home-school (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript or the equivalent, signed by the student's parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses the student completed and documents the successful completion of a secondary school education in a home-school setting.

If the student is unable to obtain the documentation listed above, he or she must contact the financial aid office.

The student **must appear in person** at Northeastern State University (Financial Aid Department) to verify his or her identity by **presenting a valid government-issued photo identification (ID)**, such as, but not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport. The institution will maintain a copy of the student's photo **ID that is annotated with the date it was received and the name of the official at the institution authorized to collect the student's ID**.
